### **2024-2026 Mission Grant Progress**

Our district has funded the first five district mission grants of the 2024-2026 biennium. These funded grants are

1. Concordia Seminary at St. Louis Food Bank, \$5,000
2. Epiphany Lutheran of Jackson: New Paraments and items for the Altar, \$5000
3. Forged by Fire Services, \$5,000
4. Financial Grant-In-Aid for Church Workers and Seminary Students, \$5,000
5. New Life Pregnancy Center, \$5,000

We have not yet met the final mission grant from **St. Paul Lutheran of Hammond: Handicapped Access Doors, for \$5,000**. These funds will purchase three (3) automatic door-opening kits, including installation. The kits include two push-button activators to assist people with disabilities in accessing the church. If you would like to directly contribute to the 2024-2026 final mission grant, please include "Mission Grant #6" in the memo area. As of Feb 6<sup>th</sup>, we have \$750 toward Grant #6.
